



Who is this course for?	Adults who want to improve their maths skills for employment purposes or personal, health and wellbeing reasons
Entry requirements	There are no entry requirements. We have a course for you if you want to improve your maths skills. You will be given an assessment to check where you're at and then given advice about the correct level class to join.
What will I learn on this course?	You will • gain confidence in using the maths you need for everyday life and work • work towards national qualifications • develop your maths skills in using numbers, measures, shape and space and handling data
How will I learn?	This course is one session per week. You will plan your learning with your tutor. You will be able to work at your own pace in the way that suits you best, for example in a small group, in pairs or on your own. You will also be given work to do at home.
